
Treasurer's report is: beginning balance of \$2,869.45 which expenses of \$50.00, 33.79 and 135.92 for an ending balance of \$2,649.74. Kelie mentioned that anyone not receiving the newsletter can see it on the website and also let her know.

The opportunity quilt is being finished (now done) and due by June 1 so we can start selling raffle chances. Quilts of Valor has recently presented 4 quilts to veterans. Several cuddle quilts were displayed and you can bring additional ones to any meeting. We proceeded with show and tell.

The final business at the meeting was to discuss the progress toward the 5-star quilt show currently planned for early summer 2014. JoAnn and Jo reported on recent meetings and Dana asked members to consider activities that the guild would be willing to undertake for this show.
